OLVEA's olive oil comes from a sustainable supply chain and is produced in the respect of our values. The olives are grown according to good agricultural practices (integrated production) and are harvested by hand by producers members of an organised cooperative and with whom are developed long-term relations and projects.

This Spanish supply chain is very different from the classic intensive olive-growing in the region: it **integrates production means that are respectful** of the **product**, the **planet** and the **people** (animal traction, manual harvesting, traps for harmful insects).


