OLVEA Foundation works for actions of general interest, mainly in the region of Fécamp and in the countries where the OLVEA group is established, in particular in Morocco, Mauritania, Burkina Faso and Kenya.



Throughout 2025, the OLVEA Foundation supported **cultural, educational, social and environmental initiatives** both locally in Fécamp (France) and its surrounding areas, as well as internationally.

This year's report reflects a commitment shaped by meaningful encounters, knowledge sharing, collective initiatives, and concrete projects that have contributed to the **development, solidarity, and well-being** of communities in France and abroad.

EDUCATION

Passing on Memory

« Memories of the Great War » – Lycée Guy de Maupassant, Fécamp (France)

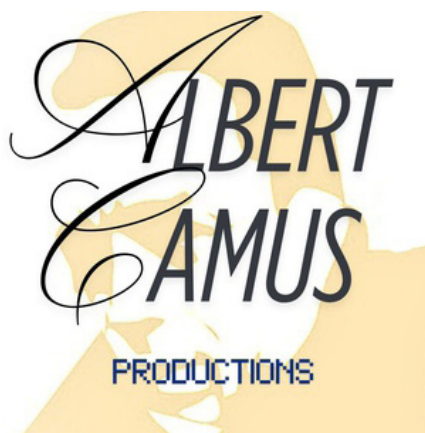
OLVEA Foundation supported two first-year classes at Lycée Guy de Maupassant as part of the **educational project « Memories of the Great War »**, carried out within the framework of the national competition « *Héritiers de mémoire* » organised by the Ministry of the Armed Forces.

The Foundation's sponsorship helped finance part of the educational trip which was essential to the project's completion. Already supported by a ministerial grant, **the initiative was also recognized at the**



Panthéon as part of the « *Science and War* », call for projects, in recognition of the students' commitment and the quality of their work.

Through this support, OLVEA Foundation reaffirmed its **commitment to education, the transmission of knowledge, and the preservation of collective memory.**



Learning Differently

Educational Podcasts - École Albert Camus, Fécamp (France)

In spring 2025, the school Albert Camus in Fécamp launched an innovative educational project focused on **podcasts creation**, with support from the association Art en Sort.

Thanks to co-funding from OLVEA Foundation, the school was able to purchase audio equipment (microphones, headphones and mixers), **enabling students to explore the world of radio and strengthen their oral expression, writing, and teamwork skills.**

Throughout the school year, several classes produced, wrote and recorded **various podcasts centered on historical figures** and reimagined tales, including Léon Dufour, Anita Conti, Bluebeard, and The Brave Little Tailor.

These productions were **showcased in municipal libraries and at the Les Pêcheries Museum in Fécamp**, highlighting the students' creativity and hard work.

Supporting Educational Success

Sponsorship Program for High-School Graduates



In July, OLVEA Foundation hosted a **signing ceremony for mentoring agreements** supporting high-school graduates from Fécamp.

Committed to education and equal opportunity since 2013, the endowment fund selected **5 new recipients** in 2025. These students received **scholarships** covering their first two years of higher education, along with **personalized tutoring** provided by professionals from the OLVEA Group or local business leaders.

The projects supported this year reflected a wide range of ambitions, including a scientific

preparatory class, an IT degree, medicine, a communication school, and a BTS CRSA.

This initiative is built on **trust**, **mentorship** and **personalized support**.

Helping Young People Envision their Future

Inter-Company Work Experience for 10th Graders



Initiated by OLVEA Foundation, **19 high-school students** from the Fécamp area took part in a unique two-week work experience programme organised in partnership with **several local companies**.

Over the course of 15 days, the students explored **more than ten professional domains**, moving to a different workplace each day. This immersion gave them the opportunity to speak with professionals, ask questions, and start envisioning their future careers.

This **collective project** reflects OLVEA Foundation's commitment to career guidance and to broadening students' understanding of the professional world.

Promoting Literacy to Broaden Horizons

Literacy Campaign (BurkinaVie charity) - Burkina Faso

Founded in 2021, BurkinaVie is a charity established by **OLVEA Burkina Faso** employees to support collective actions for **social, cultural, educational, and environmental** purposes.

OLVEA Foundation, together with the NGO CIDI and the organization FADEF-SO, financed the opening of **3 new literacy centers** in Burkina Faso.





In 2025, these centers enrolled **100 new learners**, whom this project helped develop **key skills**, strengthen their **engagement** within their community, and gain greater **autonomy**.

The organization of this new literacy campaign relied on several key levers:

- ✓ **information meetings** in villages,
- ✓ **strengthening the skills** of workshop leaders,
- ✓ **providing teaching materials**.

Supporting Children's Education

Schoolbag Distribution (MarocaVie charity) - Morocco



Between September and October, the charity MarocaVie organised a schoolbag distribution for **1,171 pupils from rural areas** in the provinces of Taroudant, Essaouira and Sidi Ifni (Morocco).

This schoolbag distribution **encouraged school attendance and helped reduce inequalities in access to education** by providing children with the tools they need to pursue their studies under better conditions.

Created by **OLVEA Morocco** in 2008, MarocaVie works to **improve living conditions in rural communities** through three pillars: education, health and economic development.

Education and School Infrastructure

Classrooms Building Project (MauritaVie charity) - Nouadhibou, Mauritania

In March, the charity MauritaVie, in partnership with the Municipality of Nouadhibou (Mauritania), **inaugurated two new classrooms** at Wajaha School, offering students a more stable and better-equipped learning environment.

Two additional classrooms are currently under construction in order to continue to develop school infrastructure and accommodate a growing number of students in improved conditions.

This project, which builds on initiatives launched in 2024, exemplifies **solidarity, local development**, and **civic responsibility**, based on a trusted partnership and rigorous oversight at every stage.



Founded in 2020, MauritaVie is a charitable association driven by **OLVEA Mauritania** employees, involved in collective actions with **social, cultural, educational, and environmental** goals in Mauritania.

CULTURE

Bringing Art into Public Spaces

Photographic Encounters - « Fécamp l'Incomparable »

From mid-June, Fécamp was transformed into an **open-air museum** with the « Photographic Encounters », a new festival initiated and supported by OLVEA Foundation.

200 photographs (large and small formats), created by **9 professional and amateur photographers**, were exhibited and displayed in **10 iconic locations** across the city, from the abbey to the beach, including the small park and the esplanade of the Palais Bénédictine.

This project also took on a **strong community dimension**, as students from Lycée Descartes designed the structures for the



« Image Trees », while middle-school students from Cuvier took part in photography workshops.

An invitation to **rediscover Fécamp through a different lens**, shaped by new perspectives and emotion.

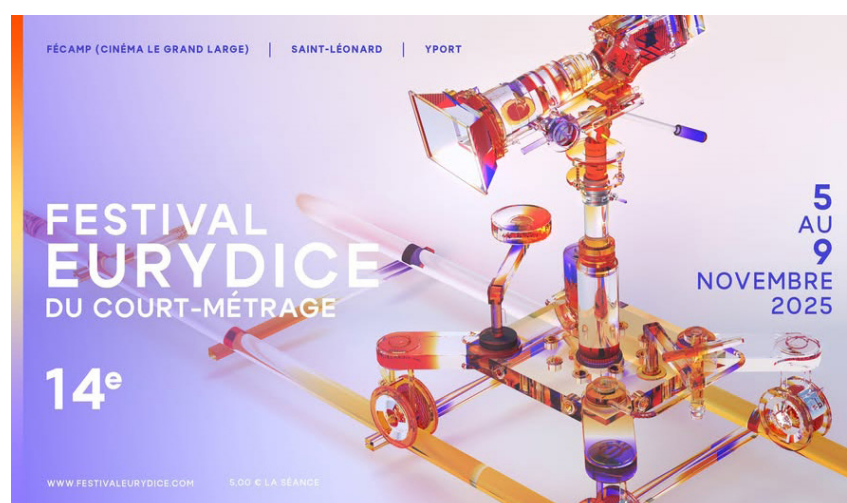

Supporting Cultural Creation

Eurydice Short Film Festival



In November, OLVEA Foundation renewed its sponsorship of the **Eurydice Short Film Festival**.

For several days, attendees were invited to discover a selection of short films **competing at the national level**, showcasing emerging talent in cinema. The festival opened at Le Grand Large (Fécamp) cinema, kicking off an edition that was **open to all** and focused on creativity.

When Music and Knowledge Meet

Commented Concert - « The Secret of Hieroglyphs »

In November, OLVEA Foundation supported the creation of « *The Secret of the Hieroglyphs* », a **commented concert** performed at Lycée Guy de Maupassant, in Fécamp.

Composed by Dominique Lemaître, in collaboration with Egyptologist Félix Relats Montserrat, the piece brought together **twenty-two musicians** in a creative dialogue **between contemporary music and Egyptology**.

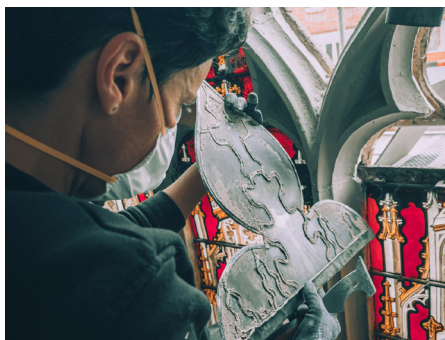
A tribute to Jean-François Champollion, the concert offered the audience a unique artistic and educational experience, at the crossroads of **science**, **culture** and **musical creation**.



HERITAGE

Preserving Heritage

Restoration of the Stained-Glass Windows of Saint-Étienne Church (Fécamp, France)



At the initiative of the OLVEA Foundation, the **second phase of the restoration** of the stained-glass windows of Saint-Étienne Church was launched in autumn, in partnership with the City of Fécamp.

This phase focused on **three 19th century windows** created by Jules Boulanger. The artworks were removed and entrusted to the Forfait workshop, while the window frames were restored by the company Lanfry.

The project schedule had to be adjusted after storm Benjamin caused damage in October 2025, requiring additional technical investigations.

Despite these constraints, the endowment fund continued **its commitment to preserving local heritage**.

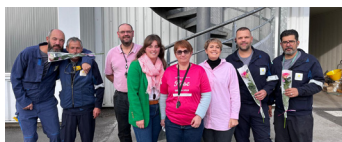
Acting for Health

Pink October: Breast Cancer Awareness Month

In October 2025, OLVEA Foundation once again joined the **Pink October** campaign.

For the 5th year running, **roses were offered to employees** at the headquarters and OLVEA Green Technologies, in partnership with Ladies' Circle 62 Fécamp. The proceeds were donated to the **French League Against Cancer**.

OLVEA's teams in Fécamp and Tholonet also took part in a **Pink Day**, demonstrating their **support** and **solidarity** in the fight against breast cancer.



Supporting Girls' Health and Education

« Menstrual Health » Program, with Mount Kenya Trust - Kenya



Supported by OLVEA Kenya employees, OLVEA Foundation partnered with the charity Mount Kenya Trust to **improve menstrual hygiene** and **promote girls' access to education**.



Thanks to this project:

- ✓ **500 girls received hygiene kits** including: reusable sanitary pads, soap, and an educational guide on puberty,
- ✓ **20 local women were trained** in pad manufacturing, creating stable income opportunities,
- ✓ **Educational sessions were organised** for girls, boys, and teachers to reduce stigma and raise awareness of menstrual health.

The reusable pads are designed to last up to two years, helping to **reduce school absenteeism** and **create a more supportive learning environment**.

The program aims to support **1,000 girls per year over two years**, enabling them to continue their education under better conditions.

Health Prevention and Equal Access

Breast Cancer Screening (MarocaVie charity) - Morocco

Between October and December, the **5th breast cancer screening campaign** took place in the Sidi Ifni region, supported by NUXE and the charity MarocaVie. The campaign focused on reaching women in rural communities.

During the first phase:

- ✓ **516 women** received consultations and breast examinations,
- ✓ **164 women** were referred for further medical follow-up.



A dedicated **screening day** was then held on 7 December 2025 at the Maison des Jeunes Sidi Mbarek:

- ✓ **175 women** were examined,
- ✓ **13 women** were referred for mammography.

By improving access to screening and medical care, this initiative helped **strengthen prevention efforts and reduce health inequalities** for women living in rural areas.



ENVIRONMENT & SPORT

Mobilising for Biodiversity

Fundraising challenge for « Les Oiseaux du Vivier » – Valmont

From 22 May to 19 June, OLVEA Foundation supported the solidarity challenge « **Des Pas pour les Oiseaux du Vivier** », organised for **International Biodiversity Day**.

83 participants joined forces to accumulate as many steps as possible in support of **APSVE**, an association

dedicated to **protecting the birds of the Vivier de Valmont**.

Together, they logged more than **7.3 million steps**, enabling a donation to be made for the **installation of nesting boxes** and the **preservation of local species**.

The challenge combined **physical activity, collective engagement, and concrete action** for biodiversity in Normandy.

Warm Hand-knitted Hats for Newborns

Hat Distribution - Maternity of Nouadhibou, Mauritania

In 2025, **hand-knitted hats made in Normandy** were sent to Mauritania and **distributed to newborns** at the maternity in Nouadhibou.

This initiative, launched by **a colleague's spouse**, was carried out on site by OLVEA's CSR team and handed over to the maternity ward by Sidahmed Sidha. The donation provided **colourful, warm hats** to newborn babies, offering comfort during their first days of life.



Sweet Treats for a Warm Christmas

Solidarity Christmas - Children of Ochakiv, Ukraine

For the year-end celebrations, OLVEA Foundation offered a **moment of warmth and joy to children** in Ochakiv with the purchase of festive treats.

Ochakiv, a coastal city in the Mykolaiv region, has been deeply impacted by the conflict. Once known as a seaside resort, it has endured years of alerts and bombardments, causing many families to leave the area.

Thanks to this support, **100 gift bags were distributed to children** still living in the city. Each bag contained a variety of biscuits and sweets (Mars, Snickers, Twix, Raffaello, etc.), amounting to over 60 kg of treats in total.

A small gesture, that brought **comfort** and a moment of **normality** to children facing a very difficult situation.
